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William Adib Samra pleads guilty to affray in Fortitude Valley bar

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William Adib Samra, 32, today pleaded guilty in Brisbane’s Magistrates Court to one count each of affray and failing to properly dispose of a needle and syringe.

Police prosecutor Subarna Raut said two men were leaving Fortitude Valley bar Maya Mexican just before 1am on December 20 when they were approached by Samra and another male.



George Bejat, 35

Alleged Comanchero. Used to own a fish and chips shop, currently has personal training business and works out of Goodlife Health Clubs in Brisbane. Lives in Newstead/Hamilton. One of the most high profile former bikies in Brisbane. Currently charged with consorting. Used to own tattoo parlours in Milton with Zivko Stojakovic and used to drive a \$165,000 yellow Lamborghini Gallardo. Bejat was sentenced to two months' jail, suspended for a year, for a "violent pack assault" of a former footballer outside Mr Mista nightclub in February 2020.



Zivko Stojakovic, 34

Alleged Comanchero. Until recently lived with mum and dad in modest unit in Coorparoo. Lives in Woolloongabba in a Palazzo Brisbane highrise. Often found living in hotels around Brisbane. Sentenced to one year's jail with immediate parole for consorting, assault and cocaine possession. Currently charged with unlicensed driving. Was convicted last year for assault by grabbing a hotel concierge and threatening to smash him and possession of cocaine at Palazzo Versace.



William Adib Samra, 32

Alleged secretary of Comachero OMCG. Coffee Club manager and supermarket manager from Doolandella. Was freed after October 15 conviction for consorting with George Bejat, Zivko Stojakovic and Matthew Mackay, because of time served on remand. Has previously pleaded guilty to affray at a Fortitude Valley open-air restaurant.



Mehran Faraji, 36

Personal trainer and former financial advisor from Kangaroo Point. Born in Iran. Keen Muay Thai kickboxer and former Bandido. Intends to plead guilty to consorting with George Bejat and Zivko Stojakovic at Brisbane Magistrates Court on December 1.



Matthew Kevin Mackay, 32

Used to work at Bootle Timber, lives in Hamilton. Due back in court December 15 on consorting charge. Has previously told court he intends to plead guilty to consorting. Past convictions for assault, including punching a soldier while wearing his Bandido vest and affray where he punched former footballer as he lay unconscious on road outside the Valley's Mr Mista nightclub.



Paea Langiotu Talakai, 30

Alleged Comanchero. Due to be sentenced on January 31 for consorting with George Bejat and Zivko Stojakovic at Hellenika between July 2020 and June this year. An ACT Magistrate concluded in 2018 that he was a member of the Comancheros.



Amein Odeh, 30

Alleged Comanchero. Butcher by trade. Runs and owns West End butcher shop. Married to former Commonwealth Bank teller-turned drug trafficker Mary Vincent Molloy. Charged with consorting with Zivko Stojakovic and George Bejat at The Calile Hotel in Fortitude Valley.



Grigori Kossian, 33

Sales rep from Bridgeman Downs. Charged with consorting at Hotel X in Fortitude Valley. Godfather to Matthew Mackay's daughter and former manager of Bejat's fish and chip shop.
