The Allan government is secretly mapping the infiltration of Victoria's biggest infrastructure projects by firms with suspected links to the underworld while warning its key contractors to purge gangland figures from their supply chains.

The moves are detailed in confidential documents from

Victoria's peak infrastructure agency that reveal the government's concern about the reach of figures such as Mick Gatto and bokie enforcers into its sprawling multibillion-dollar Big Build program.

One file includes a list of firms that officials suspect may be gangland linked and profiting – directly or indirectly – from taxpayer projects.
