

# Commission of Inquiry into the CFMEU

## and Misconduct in the Construction Industry

Cross River Rail Case Study

BUNDLE 4

***"We know you have two young sons"***

147. On 20 June 2023 there was an especially threatening incident at the Gabba Station site on the CRR.
148. Two AWU organisers had come to the site to address members on the progress toward a new EBA during the workers' lunch break.
149. The meeting should have been straightforward, but it was immediately disrupted by Richie Atutolu and another CFMEU representative who were bellowing abuse and chanting *"Australia's Weakest Union"*.
150. The meeting could not continue and the AWU organisers, together with the AWU site delegate, suspended the meeting. The AWU organisers were parked at a nearby shopping centre. As the AWU organisers then made their way to leave the site they were warned by a contractor – *"You have a crowd waiting for you"*.
151. At the front gate there were about 40 CFMEU members waiting for the AWU organisers. A contractor assisted the AWU organisers to find an escape through a side entrance, but there were about 25 CFMEU members waiting there.
152. The AWU organisers were surrounded and prevented from moving for about five minutes. Meanwhile the abuse revved up – *"What the fuck are you doing here?"*, *"You are screwing over workers"*, *"You fuckers worked on ANZAC Day"*, *"Are you scared now?"* – and more along similar lines.
153. The two AWU organisers were separated. One had his backpack ripped from his shoulders, he was pushed and shoved and encircled by angry men. Two men – one of whom has been identified as Desmond Savage – then shoulder charged the organiser, forcing him out onto the road into the path of traffic. One of the men told the organiser that he knew where he had previously worked; another said *"We won't stop coming for you – no-one can protect you"* and another said *"We know where you live"*.<sup>29</sup>
154. Then one made an especially chilling remark – *"We know you have two young sons"*.
155. The AWU organisers made their way back to the shopping centre, still surrounded by the CFMEU. The abuse continued even though they were in a public place - some of what then occurred was captured on CCTV footage taken inside the shopping centre.

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<sup>29</sup> The CFMEU men did know where the AWU organiser lived. One morning when retrieving his rubbish bins, he found those bins covered with stickers disparaging the AWU. It is known that these stickers have been designed and purchased by the CFMEU (see *The sticker campaign*, below).

156. This screenshot shows a moment during which the two AWU organisers were surrounded by over ten CFMEU members. This occurred in a public area, adjacent to the opening of the shopping centre on Stanley Street. The movement of the AWU organisers was impeded for a long period.
157. Those from the CFMEU who can be identified as involved in this incident include the organisers Brodie Wood, Dean Rielly and Matt Clark and the delegates Richie Atutolu, and Steve Amies. There are many others, who engaged in criminal conduct, who remain unidentified.
158. Rielly was asked about this incident, but claimed he had a defective memory which prevented him commenting. I had intended to ask Wood, but it had become apparent that he was not assisting the investigation. Clark, Atutolu and Amies declined to attend an interview and declined to respond in writing.

***“You don’t know who I run with”***

159. On 25 May 2023 there was an incident when an AWU organiser attended a site to engage in negotiations with an employer over a new AWU EBA. A CFMEU organiser, Blake Hynes, turned up uninvited and inserted himself into the discussions.
160. When the AWU organiser objected to Hynes’ involvement Hynes insisted they take the matter outside – “Can I have a word with this bloke?”.
161. Once outside Hynes spoke aggressively to the AWU organiser:

Hynes: “We have to work collaboratively”.

AWU: “Why – you have no coverage here”.

Hynes: “Okay. You want to be a dog”.

unable to assist. Invitations extended to Amies and Harding to be asked about this incident were declined.

171. Although Ingham had declined to attend an interview he did briefly respond by denying any knowledge of this incident.

***“Do you want to step outside with me?”***

172. On 28 February 2023 at the Gabba CRR site, two AWU organisers were conducting a scheduled meeting in the smoko shed. One of the organisers was new and was introducing himself to AWU members on-site. A CFMEU delegate, Richie Atutolu, entered the shed, disrupted the meeting, aggressively shouting abuse about the AWU.

173. When Atutolu was asked to leave he responded to the new organiser – *“Do you want to step outside with me?”* – obviously a threat of violence. When his threat was ignored, Atutolu remained in the smoko shed, disrupting the meeting by repeatedly shouting *“AWU – Australia’s Worst Union”* and heaping childish personal abuse on the new AWU organiser.

174. When the organisers were leaving, Atutolu followed them to the perimeter of the site, hurling more abuse. An opportunity for Atutolu to speak about this incident was declined by him.

**The Centenary Bridge incident**

175. On 23 February 2024 there was an incident at the Centenary Bridge site at Jindalee. Two AWU organisers had been on the site with the knowledge and permission of the contractor and were leaving in their cars, one car following the other. As the first car reached the gales and was about to enter a public road more than ten CFMEU members surrounded the car, shouting at the driver and rocking the car.

176. The scene was captured by a dashcam on the second AWU car:



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# Protesters in court over alleged wilful damage at Eagle Street

Three protesters have faced court accused of smashing the glass door of a building where federal government offices are located in Brisbane's CBD.

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#### **Glass door smashed during CFMEU protest**

A glass door is smashed at Waterfront Place in the Brisbane CBD during a CFMEUU protest.

Three protesters have faced court accused of smashing the glass door of a building where federal government offices are located in Brisbane's CBD.

The CFMMEU protest on April 5 [saw thousands of unionists march through the city](#) before descending on Waterfront Place at 1 Eagle Street.

Workers started banging fists and flags on the glass front doors of the building, which eventually shattered.

Police later charged Timothy James Maguire, 31, of Enoggera, construction worker Christopher Michael Bradby, 36, of New Beith and beauty therapist Sinead Anne Carroll, 31, of Brisbane City with wilful damage.

They briefly appeared in Brisbane Magistrates Court on Tuesday on notices to appear.

Police will allege the trio forced open the glass door causing the glass to shatter.

It will be alleged the damage to the building cost \$25,000 to repair.

All three were charged by police's Brisbane City Tactical Crime Squad.

The matter was adjourned and all three were granted bail on their own undertaking.

The workers had been marching against wage theft, sham contracting and insolvency.

The crowd quickly dispersed after the glass was broken and a CFMMEU official said at the time it was in the process of contacting building management to organise a fix to the door as a "top priority".

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# One-punch attack was self defence: court

After drinking two cartons of pre-mix cans with his brother and a friend, John Faleta went out on the town. He woke up two days later in hospital with life-threatening injuries.

He'd been knocked out by one punch, thrown by Richard Atutolu, which left him with bleeding on the brain and skull fractures, the Brisbane District Court heard.

But Atutolu denies he was a troublemaker and says he was merely defending himself.

"I'm not a troublemaker but these guys think they've got bigger chests, they can rule," Atutolu, who is on trial for grievous bodily harm, told police at the time.

"He can't walk around in the club acting like you own the s\*\*\*. Once in a while there are going to be boys who can handle themselves. We are them boys."

Atutolu doesn't deny throwing the punch, but he did so in self-defence, his barrister Andrew Hore told the jury.

"(Mr Faleta) entered a fighting stance," he said.

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"My client doesn't have to wait to be struck first by the aggressor.

"He can strike before being struck, he's entitled to do that, that is self-defence."

The alleged assault happened in the early hours of September 26, 2015 at a taxi rank near a Fortitude Valley club where Atutolu and Mr Faleta had both been drinking with friends.

Before he was allegedly attacked, Mr Faleta had run up behind another man and punched him in the back of the head, the court heard.

He was thrown out of the club, where he had earlier threatened Atutolu's friend, George Vujanovic, the jury heard.

When Mr Hore asked Mr Faleta if he solved problems using violence he shot back: "How else?".

Outside the club, Mr Fatela and Atutolu crossed paths and were soon face to face.

Mr Fatela was grinning after being told to "f\*\*\* off" by Atutolu but wasn't showing any signs of backing down, the court heard.

"His (Mr Faleta's) whole body language was aggressive," Mr Vujanovic said.

Atutolu stuck with a "palm punch" at Mr Faleta's chest or head.

And he then swung the punch which would leave Mr Faleta in an induced coma with severe head injuries.

He has since recovered but has no memory of the incident.

Several witnesses are expected to give evidence as the trial continues.

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## Qld king-hit accused had done it before

A carpenter accused of king-hitting another man during a late-night fight in Brisbane was on probation for a similar offence last month, a court has heard.

Richard Scott Atutolu, 23, was arrested and charged with grievous bodily harm after allegedly knocking a man unconscious in the clubbing district of Fortitude Valley early on Saturday morning.

The man is in an induced coma in hospital with a fractured skull and a brain bleed, police prosecutor Sergeant Scott Pearson told the Brisbane Magistrates Court on Monday.

"The real concern with this defendant is further offending and the flight risk," he said.

"There's a victim to this undergoing serious treatment."

Atutolu was convicted of assault occasioning bodily harm in August, the court heard.

"What will be different this time, Mr Atutolu?" Magistrate Ann Thacker asked.

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Atutolu's lawyer Debbie Kilroy acknowledged it was a major concern but said he had the support of his family.

"They're quite shocked obviously - and concerned for their son," she said.

Atutolu was granted bail on the conditions that he not enter the Fortitude Valley clubbing precinct, not drink alcohol or take drugs, adhere to a curfew, and surrender his passport.
